2017 marks the Inaugural Annual Event. Scholarships, trophies, and medals will all be awarded during a special closing ceremony. In addition, the top 2 from each division will be named to the Storm All-American Team of 2017.

Every bowler receives a Storm Hy-Road!

The Storm Youth Championships is designed to be a Premier Youth Scratch Bowling Event for all ages. The event allows Youth Bowlers from around the country the opportunity to compete on four (4) different oil patterns over two (2) days of competition. Every player will compete in the same number of games with total pinfall determining the winners in each of the 6 divisions (U12B, U12G, U15B, U20B, & U20G). Players age as of 8/1/2016 determines their division.

Scholarships | Awards | Trophies | Medals

- 1st Place in both the U12B and U12G will be guaranteed a \$500 scholarship
- 1st Place in the U15B, U15G, U20B, and U20G will be guaranteed a \$750 scholarship
 - All other scholarships will be awarded on a 1:4 ratio
- 1st Place in each division will be presented with the Storm Bolt Trophy
- The top 2 in each division will be named to the Storm All-American Team of 2017
- The top 3 in each division will be awarded a Gold, Silver, or Bronze Medal
- The top 3 in each division per round will be awarded Gold, Silver, or Bronze Medals

Storm Youth Championships Rules

- 1. This event will be held March 24-26, 2017 and hosted by the National Bowling Stadium in Reno, Nevada.
- 2. This event is open to youth members of the USBC and will be certified by USBC, Certification # 06563. All USBC rules will apply.
- 3. There will be 6 divisions:
 - U12B & U12G For boys & girls under 12 as of 8/1/2016.
 - U15B & U15G For boys & girls under 15 as of 8/1/2016.
 - U20B & U20G For boys & girls under 20 as of 8/1/2016.
- 4. All bowling is on a scratch basis.
- 5. Entries close on March 17, 2017 or when the tournament fills at 234 entries, whichever comes first.
- 6. Players will compete in four (4) Rounds.
 - Each Round will consist of five (5) games.
 - Each Round will be played on a different oil pattern.
 - · Players will skip pairs after each game. Skipping procedures will be announced at the event.
 - The top 3 players in each division in each Round will be presented Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals
- 7. Tournament Champions will be crowned based on their 20 game total pinfall.
- 8. Players are responsible for the accuracy of their scores.
- 9. Entry fee is \$175 per player.
- 10. Each entry includes a Storm Hy-Road (available in 12-16 lbs.) to be picked up in Reno during the event. No advanced shipping to or from the event will be permitted. No exchanges. No refunds.
- 11. The National Bowling Stadium Staff will be the Official Tournament Score Keepers.
- 12. Dress Code All bowlers must wear suitable attire. Collared, mock, or crew neck bowling shirts are required. Names shirts are preferred, but not required. Dress slacks or pants are required for males. Females may wear skirts, skorts, dress shorts, or dress slacks. Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be longer than fingertip length when standing with arms down at sides. NO JEANS, NO T-SHIRTS, AND NO HATS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME DURING COMPETITION AND THIS INCLUDES PRACTICE SESSION.
- 13. Conduct: Any conduct deemed inappropriate, including but not limited to, foul language, obscene gestures or abuse of equipment will be subject to disqualification as determined by the tournament committee. Entry fees will not be refunded.
- 14. Scholarships will be awarded on a minimum of 1:4 and all scholarships funds will be administered by S.M.A.R.T.
- 15. This tournament will offer Junior Gold Qualifiers for each Round of the tournament for an additional fee.

Saturday

There will be two Rounds of play on Saturday. Round 1 will be contested on a sport compliant medium length oil pattern and Round 2 will be contested on a sport compliant long oil pattern. All players will bowl 5 games per Round, totaling 10 games on Day 1.

Sunday

There will be two Rounds of play on Sunday. Round 3 will be contested on a modified house oil pattern and Round 4 (the final round) will be contested on a sport compliant short oil pattern. All players will bowl 5 games per Round, totaling 10 games on Day 2. The 20 total games bowled over the 4 Rounds of the event shall determine the overall finishing position in each of the 6 Divisions.
