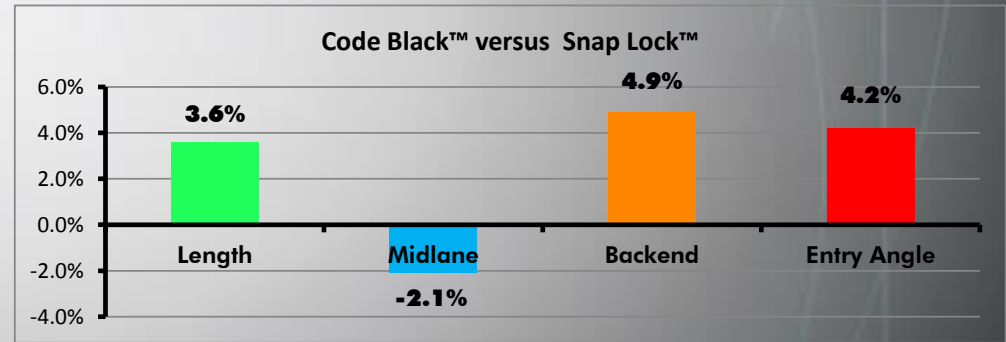

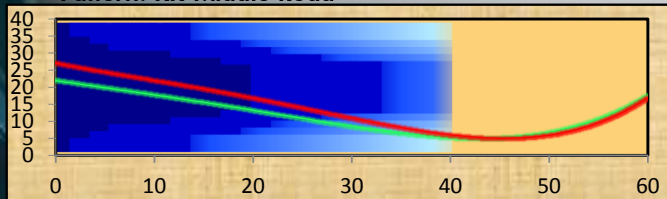

- The Code Black was cleaner through the front.
- The Snap Lock read slightly more midlane.
- The Code Black had more backend and entry angle.
- Both balls finished high flush.
