

I Josh Vine am the next bowling prodigy. I can proudly say that I use storm bowling products, I have tried to use other brands and they just don't compare. I am 15 almost 16 years of age and sustain an average of about a 176. I have a medium rev rate and a medium ball speed which makes me a very versatile player, But if needed I can make an adjustment by speeding it up or slowing it down. I currently have a storm Virtual Gravity which is 14 lbs, Storm street Rod pearl 13lbs(which I don't use), and a plastic ball 12lbs, and a Columbia 300 Freeze 14 lbs(which I regret buying). I feel that my Storm equipment reacts the best, but I also feel that having different weight equipment is detrimental to my bowling game. Another disadvantage I have is that my plastic ball is 3 years old and my street rod pearl is 1 and 3/4 years old, I feel that with all new equipment I can steadily average 190 at this point without coaching. I also feel that with the addition of some balls including the 2 furious, prodigy, and nomad pearl/solid (and/or other storm or Roto grip balls) would make a positive imprison in my game. I enjoyed throwing my Street Rod pearl in its time; this is because of its age (amount of games) and weight. I regret buying the freeze because it's simply not storm, it just does not perform for me like Storm does. I would also enjoy throwing some Roto Grip products in the future.

Thought out this past winter I bowled in a youth bowling tour which took place thought out different Long Island bowling centers(Where Jason Belmonte won his first tour title), I had a 1st and a 3rd

place victory thought out the season. I also helped lead my high school bowling team to the county championship but we lost. I feel that with some new equipment and some coaching that I will be a true force to be reckoned with on the lanes. Me being only 15 years old makes me feel that I have my whole life still before me which will allow me time to perfect my bowling craft. This also means that I am in my prime to learn and better myself for the future. I would be very grateful to be able to bowl in college. I would also like to start bowling on some PBA patterns which would help me empower my game. I have only been bowling for 3 and a half years and I feel that I took to the new sport rather quickly. I am sure that in a few short years I will hold an average over 200.

Storm and Roto Grip are in my mind as the two best bowling ball companies on the market. I would be honored one day to be sponsored by one or both of these companies. It would truly be a dream to be part of the storm or roto grip pro staff. I also feel this way because I want to learn anything and everything about bowling from how to drill up a ball to how the oil is dispersed throughout the lane.

I am very interested in how the bowling industry truly works. I do this by watching the PBA tour every Sunday throughout the winter. Some PBA stars such as Norm Duke, Pete Weber, and Wes Malott have inspired me to strive for greatness. I also will watch the PBA summer shoot out which will be airing this Sunday. I also try a stay in the loop by checking Storm.com and Roto grip.com every day or so. I am also very excited to see what balls the pros are going to be using this summer. I am anticipating the new explosive duo of the 2fast and the 2furious which promises to shred the rack. I can't wait to see Wes Malott throw the new Mutant cell pearl. I truly want to be part of the bowling industry and I hope that storm or roto grip can help introduce me to it. I feel that if I had the new releases by storm and roto grip in my hands I would enhance my approach to bowling.
