

The reason why I know I am the next Prodigy is because of my outstanding bowling skills and God-given talent to use for His honor and glory. I started bowling at around the same age as Belmo at the age of 2. I grew up watching the pros like Pete Weber, Norm Duke, Walter Ray Williams Jr., Bob Learn Jr., Dave D'Entremont, Parker Bohn III, Ricky Ward, Jason Couch, Wayne Webb, and Storm's own Randy Pedersen when i was a kid, and I still do today. Thanks to another one of Storm's own PBA players by the name of Jason Belmonte, I have learned to bowl two-handed like him and popularity of the style is rising because of him BUT there aren't that many LEFT-HANDED TWO HANDED BOWLERS!!! I myself am a PROUD lefty and am as deadly from the gutter one-handed as I am all the way inside from the 40 board with two hands. I am also a proud owner of 5 (yes...5 AND COUNTING) STORM BOWLING BALLS (VIRTUAL GRAVITY, HY-ROAD, AGENT, FURIOUS, AND SPARE STORM). My all time high game is a CLEAN 264 (10 strikes, 2 7 count spares) using my Storm Agent. The way I have my Agent set up is with a pin down-hole down layout so my reaction when throwing it one handed and straight up the gutter is a very late skid-flip with fresh oil (most cases the ball doesn't even get to the pocket because of my very high ball speed which calls me to use either my Virtual Gravity or Furious) BUT with two hands and playing deep inside with the Agent it is a very readable skid-flip. When this ball flips to the pocket, I REALLY MEAN IT FLIPS LIKE I ATTACHED A STEERING WHEEL TO IT!!!! The way I would describe myself as a bowler would be in honor of my fellow Philippine countryman by the name of Manny Pacquiao with his nickname in boxing of Pac-Man (Power, Accuracy, and Consistency). The reason for having chosen Pac-Man is because when I am bowling one handed and play up the 7-8 board and hit the pocket the pins have no choice but to keel over as dead wood (unless the 7 pin was stubborn enough to stand in its own spot or be kicked by the 4 pin and be respotted as a 9 pin true story in fact). When I strike in most cases, I really do PACK those stubborn Brunswick pins into the pit using either my Virtual Gravity or my Furious most of the time . But there are times that my strikes look like a big cranker like Jason Couch, Tommy Jones, Robert Smith, or Big Nasty Wes Malott threw the ball when there are pins flying everywhere. But allow me to get to the point...STORM IS TRULY THE BOWLER'S COMPANY!!!! As it is my dream to become a pro in the near future, IT WOULD ALSO BE AN HONOR TO BE SPONSORED BY STORM!!!!!!
