The Storm Youth Championships were created in 2017 and launched with two events. The vision for the SYC began as a way to give back to the bowling community, educate youth bowlers, and invite the whole family to participate. We have given more than \$400,000 in scholarship funds to youth athletes.

Because charitable giving has long been a focus at Storm, we've aligned the SYC with a worthy charity, Ballard vs. The Big "C." \$10 of every entry will go directly to BVBC to continue to fight the war against cancer. HOW TO ENTER

1. Go to <https://bit.ly/SYCIIdaho> on Monday, June 13 at 12 pm Mountain Time. (TIP: Save this page as a favorite so you can access it quickly on the registration day.)
2. Fill out all info (please have your child's USBC # with you when you are registering)
3. Pay the \$225 entry fee with a Visa, Mastercard, Discover, or Amex.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- This event will sell out very quickly and is on a first-come, first-serve basis
- Field size: Limited to the first 120 entries
- **Our Waiting List has gone DIGITAL.** After the event sells out, a link will be posted on stormbowling.com for those youth athletes who wish to join the waiting list. Please don't sign up for the waiting list if you entered.

SYC Divisions

The SYC offers 6 divisions based on gender and age. Use the USBC Date of Birth Chart to verify the proper division.

USBC Date of Birth Chart:

8/1/10 or later = U12

8/1/07 - 7/31/10 = U15

8/1/04-7/31/07 = U18

- In the event we do not have enough U12 entries for separate gender divisions, you will be contacted and offered the opportunity to compete in a mixed division.
- Bowlers in the U12 or U15 division may exercise the option to participate in the U15 or U18 division by notifying SYC@stormbowling.com in writing.

NOON - 1 PM - ON THE LANES WITH COACH MIKE JASNAU

Coach Mike Jasnau is a USBC Silver certified coach as well as a PBA Champion and Bowlers Journal Top 100 Coach. He has done well over 10,000 video analysis lessons. Jasnau has spent the last 20 years coaching at the National Bowling Stadium in Reno. During that time he has helped thousands of bowlers of all abilities to improve their games, including many PBA and PWBA touring pros and top amateur Champions. He'll be sharing some knowledge with our SYC Athletes.

2-3 PM - SHOWDOWN WITH THE DOODS - Blake & Adam the Bowling Doodles showcase their skills!

August is recognized as NATIONAL DOG MONTH and since we're visiting the famous Blake & Adam The Bowling Doodle's hometown and we're going to see who will take home all the bones in a 1-game match! You won't want to miss these two in action.

3-4:30 PM PRACTICE SESSION

The SYC KEGEL Patterns used for qualifying will be available for practice.

REMINDER: Dress code will be relaxed during practice session. Shorts (longer than fingertip length when standing) and t-shirts are permitted FOR PRACTICE SESSION ONLY. No tank tops or leggings allowed at any time throughout the tournament. Please refer to the rules for the tournament dress code.

SCORE SHEETS & LIVE SCORING

Players are responsible for recording their scores on the scoresheets provided by the tournament staff. Please make sure your scoresheet is filled out completely including the +/- totals. The scoresheets for each pair will be stapled together. Please leave the full packet on the front table in the settee area for the score monitors. If you have questions, please ask the tournament staff. If you lose your scoresheet, please notify the SYC tournament staff immediately.

Scores will be updated live throughout the block through the official scoring system of the SYC, BowlMetrix, and posted on stormbowling.com/SYC at the completion of each block

Competition will also be livestreamed on the **Storm Bowling Facebook Channel**. It will be saved after competition is complete.

AWARDS CEREMONIES

The SYC recognizes players each round based on their performance on each special SYC Kegel Oil Pattern. The top 3 players in each division will earn a Gold, Silver, or Bronze medals. Tournament Champions in each division will be crowned based on their 15 game total pinfall and will be announced immediately following the last round of competition. It is not mandatory to stay for the Awards Ceremony, however, we hope you will join us to celebrate our champions.

SYC RULES

1. Event will be held August 12-14 at Westy's Garden Lanes. Friday activities are optional.
2. This event is certified by the USBC and is only open to USBC Youth Members. If you are not currently a USBC Youth member, you may purchase a membership by visiting bowl.com prior to the start of competition. (Reminder: If you haven't started league yet, USBC Membership has a grace period through October 1 in tournament play.)
3. Balance holes are no longer permitted in USBC certified competition.
4. There will be 6 divisions. U18B, U18G, U15B, U15G, U12B, U12G. If a division has less than 6 players, it will be combined with another division. If a player does not wish to compete in a co-ed division a full refund will be awarded and a player on the waiting list will be added to the event.
5. All competition is scratch.
6. Entries close when the event is sold out at 120 players.
7. Each pair will have six (6) players who will compete in three (3) rounds. Each round will consist of five (5) games.
8. The top 3 players in each round will be presented Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals. Tournament Champions will be crowned based on their 15 game total pinfall. In the event of a tie for the overall champion in a division, co-champions will be awarded.
9. Entry fee is \$225 per player
10. Each entry includes a Storm Nova (available 12-16 lbs.) and swag bag. Ball can be picked up at Westy's Lanes during registration hours. No advanced shipping to or from the event will be permitted. No exchanges.
11. **REFUND POLICY: To withdraw, please contact the SYC Team at syc@stormbowling.com. A full refund is available up to 14 days prior to the event. Emergency situations, illness, situations regarding COVID-19 will be handled on a case-by-case basis.**
12. The SYC Staff and Westy's will be the official score keepers. Scores will be posted on BowlMetrix.com.
13. **SYC Dress Code** will be in effect during all rounds of competition. Collared, mock, or crew neck bowling shirts are required. Name shirts are preferred, but not required. Males: Dress slacks or pants are required. Females: Dress slacks, dress shorts, skirts, or skorts are permitted. Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be longer than fingertip length when standing with arms at side. **NO JEANS, NO SWEATPANTS, NO LEGGINGS, NO T-SHIRTS, AND NO HATS ARE ALLOWED AT ANY TIME DURING COMPETITION.**
14. **Dress code will be relaxed during practice session.** Shorts (longer than fingertip length when standing) and t-shirts are permitted FOR PRACTICE SESSION ONLY. No tank tops.
15. Conduct: Any conduct deemed inappropriate, including but not limited to, foul language, obscene gestures, and/or abuse of equipment will be subject to disqualification as determined by the tournament committee. Entry fee will not be refunded.
16. Scholarships will be awarded on a 1:4 ratio and scholarship funds will be administered by S.M.A.R.T.
17. The Storm Youth Championships is hosted in a public area and we invite local fans to come out and cheer on your young bowlers! Photos & Videos may be taken of your children as they compete throughout the event. If you have questions or concerns or do not want your child featured on our social media channels, please contact syc@stormbowling.com.
18. The USBC playing rules will cover any situations not mentioned.

#SYC BELIEFS:

FRIENDSHIPS - Through the SYC, we have found that friendships are quickly formed between participants & parents. You'll be spending the whole weekend with the same group. Say hello to those who you are bowling with and ask them where they are from. You never know when you might see them on the lanes again!

RESPECT - We believe in respecting your fellow competitors. This means following one-lane courtesy, encouraging those who might be new to an SYC, and making sure all the scores are written down on the pair.

COMPETITION - The SYC names national champions at each event. We do our best to give you a safe place to learn and showcase your skills.

GIVING BACK - Every SYC gives back to a great charity! We partner with Ballard vs the Big "C" to raise funds for those who are suffering or recovering from cancer treatment. Every entry is a way to help someone else.

POSITIVE ROLE MODELS - Our SYC Athletes are always polite to the bowling centers we visit and the parents throughout the event. We don't even need to remind you! We hope that you will leave the event and continue to be a positive role model every time you step on the lanes!



TOURNAMENT CONSIDERATIONS:

The SYC began in 2017 and we have hosted events every year since the start of the tournament, including during the worldwide pandemic of 2020 & 2021. The safety of our SYC Family is **our top priority** and we know that each parent & youth bowler makes decisions that are right for them regarding the attendance of events. We do our best to encourage positive behaviors among the youth athletes and considerations towards health & wellness. **Please do not register your child if you feel uncomfortable attending an event at this time.**

- If you have a fever over 100, are feeling sick, or have come into contact with someone who has had a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days, please contact the SYC Team to withdraw from the event. While we are looking forward to seeing everyone, we care about your health and the health of those around you than your attendance!
