SCORE SHEETS & LIVE SCORING

Players are responsible for recording their scores on the scoresheets provided by the tournament staff. Please make sure your scoresheet is filled out completely including the +/- totals. The scoresheets for each pair will be stapled together. Please leave the full packet on the front table in the settee area for the score monitors. If you have questions, please ask the tournament staff. If you lose your scoresheet, please notify the SYC tournament staff immediately.

Scores will be updated live throughout the block through the official scoring system of the SYC, BowlMetrix, and posted on stormbowling.com/SYC at the completion of each block

Competition will also be live-streamed on the **Storm Bowling Facebook and YouTube Channel**. It will be saved after competition is complete.

AWARDS CEREMONIES

The SYC recognizes players each round based on their performance on each special SYC Kegel Oil Pattern. The top 3 players in each division will earn a Gold, Silver, or Bronze medals. Tournament Champions in each division will be crowned based on their 15 game total pinfall and will be announced immediately following the last round of competition. It is not mandatory to stay for the Awards Ceremony, however, we hope you will join us to celebrate our champions.

SYC RULES

- 1. Event will be held February 18-19 at South Point Bowling Plaza. Friday activities are optional.
- 2. This event is certified by the USBC and is only open to USBC Youth Members. If you are not currently a USBC Youth member, you may purchase a membership by visiting bowl.com prior to the start of competition.
- 3. Balance holes are no longer permitted in USBC certified competition.
- 4. All USBC approved bowling balls can be used in competition. The Storm Spectre and and Purple Pearl Urethane Hammer (With Serial #'s Starting with a 6 or 7) are not permitted in USBC Competition.
- 5. There will be 6 divisions. U18B, U18G, U15B, U15G, U12B, U12G. If a division has less than 6 players, it will be combined with another division. If a player does not wish to compete in a co-ed division a full refund will be awarded and a player on the waiting list will be added to the event.
- 6. All competition is scratch.
- 7. Entries close when the event is sold out at 180 players.
- 8. Each pair will have six (6) players who will compete in three (3) rounds. Each round will consist of five (5) games.
- 9. The top 3 players in each round will be presented Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals. Tournament Champions will be crowned based on their 15 game total pinfall. In the event of a tie for the overall champion in a division, co-champions will be awarded.
- 10. Entry fee is \$225 per player
- 11. Each entry includes a Storm Night Road (available 12-16 lbs.) and swag bag. Ball can be picked up at the South Point Bowling Plaza during registration hours. No advanced shipping to or from the event will be permitted. No exchanges.
- 12. REFUND POLICY: To withdraw, please contact the SYC Team at syc@stormbowling.com. A full refund is available up to 14 days prior to the event. Emergency situations, illness, situations regarding COVID-19 will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
- 13. The SYC Staff and South Point will be the official score keepers. Scores will be posted on BowlMetrix.com.
- 14. **SYC Dress Code** will be in effect during all rounds of competition. Collared, mock, or crew neck bowling shirts are required. Name shirts are preferred, but not required. Males: Dress slacks or pants are required. Females: Dress slacks, dress shorts, skirts, or skorts are permitted. Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be longer than fingertip length when standing with arms at side. **NO JEANS, NO SWEATPANTS, NO LEGGINGS, NO T-SHIRTS, AND NO HATS ARE ALLOWED AT ANY TIME DURING COMPETITION**.
- 15. **Dress code will be relaxed during practice session.** Shorts (longer than fingertip length when standing) and t-shirts are permitted FOR PRACTICE SESSION ONLY. No tank tops.
- 16. Conduct: Any conduct deemed inappropriate, including but not limited to, foul language, obscene gestures, and/or abuse of equipment will be subject to disqualification as determined by the tournament committee. Entry fee will not be refunded.
- 17. Scholarships will be awarded on a 1:4 ratio and scholarship funds will be administered by S.M.A.R.T.
- 18. The Storm Youth Championships is hosted in a public area and we invite local fans to come out and cheer on your young bowlers! Photos & Videos may be taken of your children as they compete throughout the event. If you have questions or concerns or do not want your child featured on our social media channels, please contact syc@stormbowling.com.
- 19. The USBC playing rules will cover any situations not mentioned.
