The Storm Youth Championships were created in 2017 and launched with two events. The vision for the SYC began as a way to give back to the bowling community, educate youth bowlers, and invite the whole family to participate. Since 2017, the SYC has awarded \$940K in scholarship funds to youth bowlers. Since that first event, the SYC has welcomed thousands of youth athletes and their parents to celebrate the best parts of bowling. At every SYC, we encourage every person in attendance to make a new friend, learn a few things, and give back to the bowling community by raising money and awareness for the chosen charities.

USBC Youth Membership is good through October 1 of the following season for summer leagues and tournaments. Youth who turn 18 during the season are not granted the October 1 extension for tournament play; youth membership expires July 31 of the season in which they turn 18 years old.

ELIGIBILITY & DIVISIONS

- Open to all USBC Youth Members (under age 18 as of August 1)
- No average requirement or qualification needed. Whether it's your first large event or you're a member of Junior Team USA, all levels of bowlers are welcome.
- Bowlers in the U12 or U15 division may exercise the option to participate in the U15 or U18 division by notifying SYC@stormbowling.com in writing.
- If a division has less than 6 players, it will be combined with another division. If a player does not wish to compete in a co-ed division a full refund will be awarded and a player on the waiting list will be added to the event.

BEFORE REGISTRATION DAY:

1. Ensure you have an active USBC Youth Membership You can do this through your USBC Youth League or online here: <https://bowl.com/about-us/join-now>
2. Have a credit card ready
3. Know your ball weight preference

REGISTRATION STEPS:

1. Visit stormbowling.com on **December 16** at Noon Mountain Time and click the REGISTER button. This will take you to the SYC Registration Page on Pinwheel.

2. Fill out all information:


3. On the last page, it will inform you whether you are registering for the event or if you are in waiting list status.
4. Next, you will be taken to a payment page. You will input your credit card information (\$225 entry fee: Visa, Mastercard, Discover or Amex accepted).

If you are in the event your card will be charged immediately. If you are on the waiting list, your card will not be charged until you are moved into the event.

5. If you have a duplicate charge (multiple people trying to enter one child), you will receive a refund for the duplicate entry minus the CC Processing Fees (Approx: \$7)

CONGRATS! You just joined the SYC Family! What's next?

1. You should get a confirmation email with your entry from notify@pinwheelmail.com. within 10 minutes.
2. If you do not receive this email, don't panic. We will send a follow-up email from syc@stormbowling.com before 8 pm Mountain Time.
3. You will start receiving emails every single Friday with information about the upcoming event. If the first Friday passes and you do not receive an email, please contact syc@stormbowling.com so we can verify your email address.



THE WAITING LIST

- In the event we do not have enough U12 entries for separate gender divisions, you will be contacted and offered the opportunity to compete in a mixed division.
- Bowlers in the U12 or U15 division may exercise the option to participate in the U15 or U18

HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE WAITING LIST

- The waiting list is first come, first serve so if the status says you are in waiting list status, register immediately. (It is the same registration page)
- You will be asked to input your form of payment. Your card will not be charged until you are moved from the waiting list into the event.
- We can NOT sign you up on the waiting list if you call us or email us. This can only be completed digitally.
- If you are local, we strongly encourage that you sign up for the waiting list.

HOW & WHEN YOU ARE NOTIFIED

- We will send out an email with the waiting list based on your time stamped entry within 48 hours of the registration.
- We will send out an email weekly with your placement on the waiting list. If there are no changes, you may not receive an email that week.
- Bowlers can receive a full refund 14 days (minus CC processing fees) leading up to the event. Emergencies are handled on a case-by-case basis. The majority of the withdrawals will come within 3 weeks of the event.
- One week prior to the event, you may be contacted in case there are last-minute withdrawals (within 48 hours) to be added to a list of bowlers who can travel at the last minute.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE SYC



Look for the check-in banner when you arrive at the bowling center for the first time! The SYC Team will be ready to greet you and answer any questions you may have about the weekend.

Each SYC Bowler is required to check-in ONE time at South Point Bowling Plaza to receive their bowling ball and swag bag before bowling begins on Saturday morning.

Once you check-in, look for the SYC Tournament Info wall. Lane assignments and all the information you will need will be posted here.

If you won't be arriving at the SYC on Friday, email syc@stormbowling.com to let us know that you will be checking-in on Saturday.



THE EVENT

Our SYC Team continues to strive to create events that include a welcoming environment where youth bowlers and their families are invited to visit great bowling communities, meet new friends, and learn by competing on challenging conditions developed by KEGEL.

Each event includes optional activities that are available for bowlers who wish to participate in the popular activities. These include seminars focused on educating athletes and their families led by one of our Team Storm members and a practice session on the patterns. In addition, we host social activities that allow the SYC families to get to know each other off the lanes when our schedule allows.

The top three bowlers in each gender and age-based division are awarded with bronze, silver and gold medals. In addition to the scholarship funds awarded to participants, at the conclusion of the tournament the overall champions receive a special SYC trophy, medal, and earn a SYC banner that will be hung at each SYC event until they age-out of competition.

Final Awards Presentation & Closing Ceremonies will take place after Round 3.

Tournament Champions in each division will be crowned based on their 15 game total pinfall and will be announced immediately following the last round of competition. It is not mandatory to stay for the Awards Ceremony, however, we hope you will join us to celebrate our champions. If you can not stay due to travel, let us know and we will mail you your award. The awards ceremony is usually complete by 3 pm at most events.

SCORES AT THE SYC



Players are responsible for recording their scores on the scoresheet provided by the tournament staff. Please make sure your scoresheet is filled out completely including the +/- totals. If you have questions, please ask the tournament staff. If you lose your scoresheet, please notify the SYC tournament staff immediately.

Scores will be updated live throughout the block through the official scoring system of the SYC, BowlmetriX. You can visit bowlmetrix.com to view current and past results from the SYC.

Once you bowl in a tournament using BowlmetriX, your profile will be created. Any event using BowlmetriX will be added to your profile.

- Full refund minus credit card fees available up to 14 days before event

- Emergency situations handled case-by-case

SCORING

- Official scoring through BowlmetriX
- Players must complete paper scoresheets and verify their scores after each game
- Report missing scoresheets immediately

EQUIPMENT RULES

- All USBC approved bowling balls permitted
- Exceptions:
 - Storm Spectre not allowed
 - Purple Pearl Urethane Hammer (Serial #'s 6/7) not allowed
- Balance holes not permitted

WEEKLY EMAILS

- Once you register, you will receive weekly emails every Friday with information about the event.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

- Each SYC Bowler is required to check-in ONE time to receive their bowling ball and swag bag before bowling begins on Saturday morning.
- Once you check-in, look for the SYC Tournament Info wall. Lane assignments and all the information you will need will be posted here.

PRACTICE SESSIONS

- The SYC KEGEL Patterns used for qualifying will be available for practice. There are NO lane assignments for practice and you do not need to check-in prior to practice.
- Dress Code for Practice Session is relaxed.

COMPETITION

- Competition Dress Code is in effect
- All bowlers will compete in 3 rounds on 3 different KEGEL patterns. Each round consists of five games.
- The top 3 players in each round will be presented Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals. These awards are presented before the next round of competition begins.
- Tournament Champions in each division will be crowned based on their 15 game total pinfall and will be announced immediately following the last round of competition in an awards presentation. In the event of a tie for the overall champion in a division, co-champions will be awarded.

PRO SHOP INFO

- The pro shop on site can drill your new Storm Bowling Ball for the tournament if you wish. Just bring a current ball or your specs from your pro shop and visit the team at the pro shop!

SYC RULES



1. Event will be held February 15-16 at South Point Bowling Plaza. Friday activities are optional.
2. This event is certified by the USBC and is only open to USBC Youth Members. If you are not currently a USBC Youth member, you may purchase a membership by visiting bowl.com prior to the start of competition.
3. Balance holes are no longer permitted in USBC certified competition.
4. All USBC approved bowling balls can be used in competition. The Storm Spectre and and Purple Pearl Urethane Hammer (With Serial #'s Starting with a 6 or 7) are not permitted in USBC Competition.
5. There will be 6 divisions. U18B, U18G, U15B, U15G, U12B, U12G. If a division has less than 6 players, it will be combined with another division. If a player does not wish to compete in a co-ed division a full refund will be awarded and a player on the waiting list will be added to the event.
6. All competition is scratch.
7. Entries close when the event is sold out at 180 players.
8. All players will compete in three (3) rounds. Each round will consist of five (5) games.
9. If you need to withdraw during the event due to an emergency, find a tournament official.
10. The top 3 players in each round will be presented Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals.
Tournament Champions will be crowned based on their 15 game total pinfall. In the event of a tie for the overall champion in a division, co-champions will be awarded.
11. Entry fee is \$225 per player
12. Each entry includes a Storm Summit Ascent (available 12-16 lbs.) and swag bag. Ball can be picked up at the Plaza during registration hours. No advanced shipping to or from the event will be permitted. No exchanges.
- 13. REFUND POLICY: To withdraw, please contact the SYC Team at syc@stormbowling.com. A full refund (minus CC processing fees) is available up to 14 days prior to the event. Emergency situations and illness will be handled on a case-by-case basis.**
14. The SYC Staff will be the official score keepers. Scores will be posted on BowlMetrix.com.
15. SYC Dress Code will be in effect during all rounds of competition. Collared, mock, or crew neck bowling shirts are required. Name shirts are preferred, but not required. Males: Dress slacks or pants are required. Females: Dress slacks, dress shorts, skirts, or skorts are permitted. Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be longer than fingertip length when standing with arms at side. NO JEANS, NO SWEATPANTS, NO LEGGINGS, NO T-SHIRTS, AND NO HATS ARE ALLOWED AT ANY TIME DURING COMPETITION.
16. Dress code will be relaxed during practice session. Shorts (longer than fingertip length when standing) and t-shirts are permitted FOR PRACTICE SESSION ONLY. No tank tops.
17. Conduct: Any conduct deemed inappropriate, including but not limited to, foul language, obscene gestures, and/or abuse of equipment will be subject to disqualification as determined by the tournament committee. Entry fee will not be refunded.
18. Scholarships will be awarded on a 1:4 ratio and scholarship funds will be administered by S.M.A.R.T.
19. The Storm Youth Championships is hosted in a public area and we invite local fans to come out and cheer on your young bowlers! Photos & Videos may be taken of your children as they compete throughout the event. If you have questions or concerns or do not want your child featured on our social media channels, please contact syc@stormbowling.com.
20. The USBC playing rules will cover any situations not mentioned.



SYC BELIEFS



FRIENDSHIPS - Through the SYC, we have found that friendships are quickly formed between participants & parents. You'll be spending the whole weekend with the same group. Say hello to those who you are bowling with and ask them where they are from. You never know when you might see them on the lanes again!

RESPECT - We believe in respecting your fellow competitors. This means following one-lane courtesy, encouraging those who might be new to an SYC, and making sure all the scores are written down on the pair.

COMPETITION - The SYC names national champions at each event. We do our best to give you a safe place to learn and showcase your skills.

GIVING BACK - Every SYC gives back to a great charity! We partner with Ballard vs the Big "C" and Make-A-Wish Utah to raise funds for those who are suffering or recovering from cancer treatment. Every entry is a way to help someone else.

POSITIVE ROLE MODELS - Our SYC Athletes are always polite to the bowling centers we visit and the parents throughout the event. We don't even need to remind you! We hope that you will leave the event and continue to be a positive role model every time you step on the lanes!

TOURNAMENT CONSIDERATIONS

The SYC began in 2017 and we have hosted events every year since the start of the tournament, including during the worldwide pandemic of 2020 & 2021. The safety of our SYC Family is our top priority and we know that each parent & youth bowler makes decisions that are right for them regarding the attendance of events. We do our best to encourage positive behaviors among the youth athletes and considerations towards health & wellness.

- If you have a fever over 100, are feeling sick, please contact the SYC Team to withdraw from the event. While we are looking forward to seeing everyone, we care about your health and the health of those around you than your attendance!
- **REFUND POLICY:** To withdraw, please contact the SYC Team at syc@stormbowling.com. A full refund (minus CC processing fees) is available up to 14 days prior to the event. Emergency situations, illness, situations regarding COVID-19 will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
- Due to the number of requests that we have received, we can no longer honor pairing requests at this time. If an SYC is held at two centers, we will announce a deadline for squad requests.
- If you have an issue about scoring or something on the lanes, please find a SYC Volunteer immediately.
- No parents or coaches are permitted in the designated bowlers area.
- As always, if you see something or feel uncomfortable at any time, please locate an SYC Team Member.



UNWRITTEN RULES FOR TOURNAMENT BOWLERS

We practice one-lane courtesy at SYC Events. Please be sure to look to the right and left before starting your approach.

Respect your fellow competitors. Just because you finish your game, do not enter the next settee area until the pair is done.

Any Issues During The Round

If you have issues during a game such as a scoring issue or anything you need help with, find a tournament official and clearly explain what occurred. The official will ask other bowlers on the pair if they saw what occurred.

If you have a foul dispute, stay at the line and ask another bowler to check to make sure your foot is behind the line. Then find an official.

Writing Down the Scores

One bowler (or parent) can volunteer to keep scores for the pair at the SYC. This is usually the first person who finishes on the pair. We ask that these sheets are left in the bowlers area so our score keepers can easily find them when they are collecting scores between games.

If you are NOT writing down your scores, check your score to be sure that it is written correctly.

Make a Friend

Introduce yourself to all the bowlers on your pair before you get started. Parents, this goes for you too! Great friends are made at the SYC & other parents have great advice for traveling, finding tournaments, and competition.

Being a Good Sport

Be a good sport! You never know who's watching and learning from your actions. We have all ages at the SYC. You never know who you might become a role model to.

Bullying

Bullying will NOT be tolerated. If you see something, please report this to an official.

Saying Thanks

When you are done with the tournament, thank the tournament team, bowling center team, and anyone else organized with the event. Tournaments take a great deal of time and planning.



THE CHAMPIONS

SYC Champions continue to demonstrate their dedication to the sport of bowling after the event concludes. Many continue to find ways to give back to their local communities and encourage other youth athletes to participate in competitive activities or even find ways to start their own youth tournaments to grow the sport.

Past champions have continued to excel at the youth level earning national titles and representing the United States on Jr. Team USA. Some of the athletes have also used what they learn to compete collegiately and even on the PBA and PWBA Tours. Their dedication to the sport is evident but SYC athletes also learn to be dedicated to giving back and staying committed to their education. Through scholarship and the opportunities to learn about college bowling, athletes develop a desire to continue to learn at a higher level and discover their passions. The opportunities available to these bowlers through the sport of bowling are endless. The SYC builds connections for these families that can last a lifetime.

Junior Team USA member, Gianna Brandolino, age 16, recently made history by earning her 13th SYC title at the 2024 SYC New York. This achievement makes her the most decorated SYC bowler ever. Brandolino earned her first SYC title at the first event she bowled in Smyrna in 2019. The Brandolino family have been supportive of the SYC events and their fellow competitors since Gianna was in the U12 division. Brandolino also competed in the PTQ for the PWBA Rockford Open and made it into the main field.

Prior to Brandolino's historic achievement, the SYC title record was held by Spencer Robarge at 12 SYC titles, which remains the record for boys. Robarge, who now attends Wichita State University, finished third at the 2021 USBC Masters. He was named the National Collegiate Bowling Coaches Association (NCBCA) Rookie of the Year in 2022. In 2023, he was named NCBCA Most Valuable Player and NCBCA Player of the Year. Jillian Martin, another past SYC champion, notably became the youngest PWBA Champion at 17 years old, earning the 2021 PWBA BowlTV Classic title. She was named NTCA Rookie of the Year in 2023 and earned the U.S. Amateur Title in 2023 and made two stepladder finals on the 2023 PWBA Tour. In 2024, Martin added to her impressive resume by becoming the youngest to win a USBC Queens title in Green Bay and secured another PWBA title during the 2024 PWBA Tour Season. Both Robarge and Martin are currently members of Team USA.

"The SYC was created and continues to be conducted with a pure heart and clear vision that youth are the future of the sport," Hulsenberg said. "If you have bowled or plan to bowl an SYC, we thank you. We are committed to growing the sport together and continuing to do good along the way."
